#CITES permit / certificate – <b>Express service fee payable</b>	1070	R450 administration fee per application	<p>Businesses/traders may register with WCNCB at a once-off payment of <b>R8500</b> per annum or 150 permits/certificates, <b><u>whichever expires first.</u></b></p> <p>In other words, if you pay <b>R8500</b> on 1 April 2026 and are issued 150 permits any time before 1 April 2027, you will have to pay <b>R8500</b> for another 150 permits/certificates (or year from the date of that payment). On the other hand if you've only used 120 permits from your original 150 by 1 April 2027, your registration expires and you'll have to pay <b>R8500</b> then for another year (or 150 permits/certificates). Permits remaining from the original 150 are not carried over from year to year.</p> <p><b>Express service applications will be taken from the above-mentioned 150 permits/certificates.</b></p> <p>A fee concession may be considered in respect of applications received from recognised research institutions or projects, and in respect of conservation programs that are not conducted for commercial gain.</p>
