## I, the applicant, hereby declare that I take note of and understand:

- That the onus is on me to acquaint myself with all legislation pertaining to the growing, selling, transport and possesion of endangered flora.
- That the onus is on me to acquaint myself with all legislation pertaining to the international trade (import / export) in endangered flora and that additional permits (e.g. CITES and/or Department of Agriculture) may be required.
- That the onus is on me to verify the current conservation status of any flora species that is to be grown and / or sold prior to acquisition, cultivation or sale on the SANBI Red List of South African Plants at <a href="http://redlist.sanbi.org/">http://redlist.sanbi.org/</a> and/or </a>
- That a registration certificate to grow and / or sell endangered flora does not authorise me to propagate or trade in endangered flora without an accompanying valid permit to cultivate and / or sell endangered flora.
- That the onus is on me to ascertain whether any additional permits or authorisations are required from other local / provincial and / or national authorities (e.g. municipal approval etc.)
- That I may only grow and / or sell endangered flora on or from the premises listed on my registration certificate.
- That a cultivation and/or selling permit does not authorise me to collect any endangered flora from the veld.

- That I must keep an invoice book in which the following information is specified: a) my full name and address, b) the full name and address of the buyer / receiver, c) the number and expiry date of my permit to sell endangered flora and d) the species name and quantity of each species which is being sold or donated.
- That I can be held responsible for reimbursement of the costs incurred by CapeNature to conduct an inspection if the minimum requirements for a permit / license are not met.
- That, in the case of repeated offences or failure to comply with permit conditions, it may lead to the cancellation of permits / licenses and/or the witholding of future permits / licenses.
- That, in the case of an offence regarding the specimen(s) contained in this application, the specimen(s) may be confiscated / seized by CapeNature.
