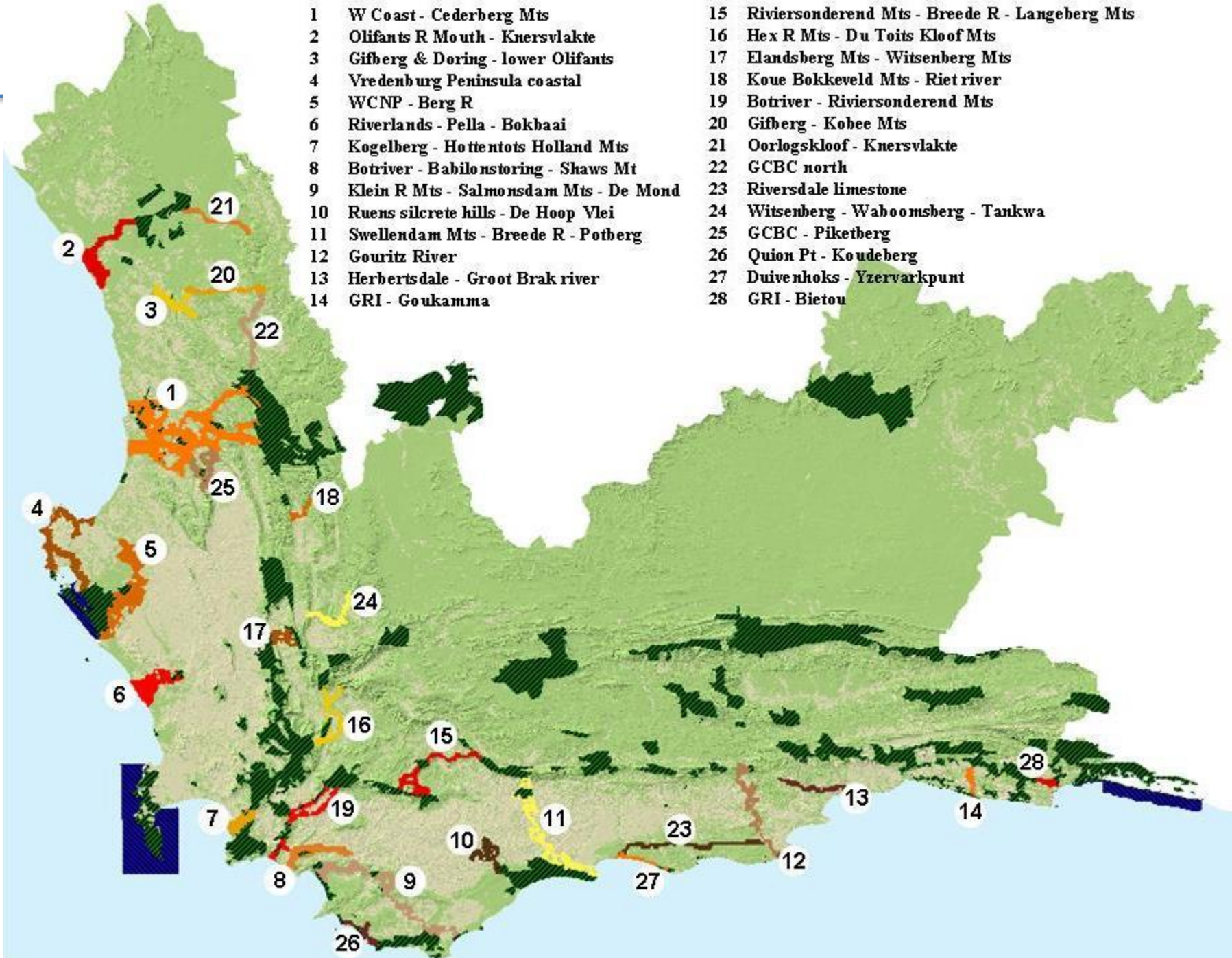

---

1. **Invasive Alien Plant** Management
2. **Agriculture**, including overgrazing and illegal ploughing
3. **Fire** Management
4. **Water** Resource Management
5. **Urbanization** and Development
6. **Mining**



# THE FIVE STRATEGIES FOR INTERVENTION

---

1. **Direct management interventions** that restore and maintain a healthy environment
2. **Direct land purchase** – Identification of where purchase of critical sites is required
3. **Improved enforcement and compliance**
4. **Improved educational awareness** of legal requirements and best practice
