CapeNature has six Eco-Venues that are geared toward accommodating small to medium groups of people for a variety of activities including meetings, environmental education, specialised group outings and social events. Day programmes for schools.

Overnight programmes for schools

We offer programmes that extend over three days and two nights and can include camping on a reserve or eco-venue. You'll learn about fire safety and species conservation through races and activities, puzzles, crafts, hiking and stargazing – all while enjoying the magic that an outdoor camping experience offers! Rates start from R110 per person per night.

Environmental programmes & team building resources

Visitors are able to select between self- facilitated (run by the group organiser) and facilitated (run by CapeNature staff) programmes at our Eco-Venues.

Currently, facilitated educational programmes are offered for children and adults. Curriculum aligned programmes are also available to schools. All equipment will be provided. Facilitated programmes are subject to availability and must be arranged well in advance. The booking agent should be informed on booking if a facilitated programme is required.
