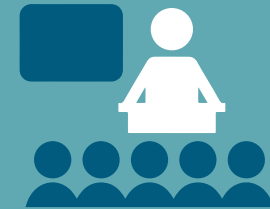
As custodian of the province's natural environment, CapeNature is tasked with nature conservation and awareness, preserving biodiversity, and providing facilities for education, research and training.

Environmental programmes & team building resources

Visitors are able to select between self-facilitated (run by the group organiser) and facilitated (run by CapeNature staff) programmes at our Eco-Venues.

Currently, facilitated educational programmes are offered for children and adults. Curriculum aligned programmes are also available to schools. All equipment will be provided.
