

CapeNature CEDERBERG WILDERNESS Kliphuis





Kliphuis, situated on the flower route to the Biedouw valley and Wupperthal, offers 3 self-catering cottages and an upgraded campsite. Set against the backdrop of the famous Rocklands bouldering site, it is the perfect spot for climbing enthusiasts. The shady campsite has 14 sites and lies on the Kliphuis River in the northern section of the Cederberg Wilderness, in the Pakhuis Pass. You need a valid permit for bouldering activity which is obtainable from the Kliphuis office, De Pakhuys, Kleinfontein or Traveller's Rest. Bouldering/rock climbing is allowed at the Kliphuis campsite area on condition you stay at CapeNature premises. The rest of the area is excluded from these terms and a permit is required.



Take the N7 north from Cape Town. Stay on the N7 until you get to Clanwilliam. Follow the R364 for about 17km in an easterly direction until you get to Kliphuis campsite. Please report to the office on arrival before entering the camp or cottages. This is a 280km drive, which should take about three hours.



THERE IS NO SHOP AT KLIPHUIS Food, beverages and other provisions must be bought beforehand.

Please bring CHARCOAL or ECO LOGS for your braai. These items are sold at selected reserves. Please enquire with the reserve before arrival.

Keep the surrounds and facilities clean.

Tread lightly – avoid stepping on new vegetation or seedlings.

When bouldering, stick to established climbing sites and keep the human footprint to a minimum.
