## INFORMATION DOCUMENT FOR A PERMIT TO TRANSPORT AND EXPORT WILD ANIMALS OUT OF THE PROVINCE FOR SHOW PURPOSES

**I, the owner, and I, the transporter, hereby declare that I take note of and understand:**

- That the onus is on me to acquaint myself with all legislation pertaining to the transport, trading and possession of wild animals and wild animal carcasses.
- That the onus is on me to acquaint myself with all legislation pertaining to the international movement (import / export) of wild animals and wild animal carcasses and that additional permits (e.g. CITES) may be required.
- That I can apply for permits at my nearest CapeNature regional office.
- That I must have the necessary permit in my possession prior to commencing any activity with a wild animal.
- That any permit has an expiry date and that the onus is on me to apply for the renewal of any permits at least fifteen (15) working days prior to the expiration.
- That a transport and export permit does not authorise me to import or keep wild animals in captivity.
- That a transport and export permit does not authorise me to transport or export endangered wild animals or their carcasses.
- That this transport and export permit is valid for one consignment only.
- That the transport of live wild animals must be done in accordance with the Animal Protection Act of 1962 and container / enclosure / trailer specifications must adhere to the International Air Transport Association's Live Animals Regulations.
- That only the wild animals listed on the permit may be transported.
- That CapeNature does not support, condone nor encourage any non-essential wild animal-human physical contact or interaction. CapeNature regards such activity as highly irresponsible, undesirable and potentially dangerous, and urges permit-holders to refrain therefrom at all times. By signing this information document, the applicant takes note of CapeNature's position statement in this regard and indemnifies CapeNature fully against any claim.
- That I must, at all times, ensure the safety of the public during transport, temporary captivity and the exhibition of wild animals.
- That officials of CapeNature may conduct inspections or investigations of my equipment, facilities and the wild animals at any time to ensure compliance to the applicable legislative requirements.
- That it is an offence to commence any activity with a wild animal without being in possession of a valid permit and / or license authorising that particular activity.
- That in certain cases I may need additional permits from Veterinary Services (e.g. transport and/or import of certain wild animals, Performing Animal Protection Act license etc.)
- That the onus is on me to determine whether the destination province's nature conservation authority requires an import permit for the wild animal(s) to be imported into their province and that no permit issued by CapeNature exempts me (the holder thereof) from complying with the destination province's or national legislation pertaining to the wild animal(s) contained in my application.
- That the onus is on me to determine whether any of the species of wild animal(s) that I am applying for is listed as an alien and invasive species as per the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act (10/2004): Alien and Invasive Species List. No permit issued by CapeNature exempts me (the holder thereof) from complying with the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act (10/2004): Alien and Invasive Species Regulations.
- That I can be held responsible for reimbursement of the costs incurred by CapeNature to conduct an inspection if the minimum requirements for a permit / license are not met.
- That, in the case of repeated offences or failure to comply with permit conditions, it may lead to the cancellation of permits / licenses and/or the withholding of future permits / licenses.
- That, in the case of an offence regarding the wild animal(s) contained in this application, the wild animal(s) may be confiscated / seized by CapeNature.
