Bliss on the Bay is based in the coastal town of Pringle Bay between Rooi Els and Betty's Bay. This amazing house is truly unique and one of a kind in the CapeNature stable of properties. It's superbly located, within the Brodie Link Nature Reserve of Kogelberg Nature Reserve Complex which is at the core of Kogelberg Biosphere, on the outskirts of Pringle Bay village in the Overberg. Being quite elevated, the views from the house towards the village and the beach are spectacular! One cannot get any closer to nature - surrounded by fynbos, the house lends itself to total privacy, being the only property within that area.

The private wood fired Kol-Kol hot tub on the back deck is definitely a key attraction. Relaxing in the tub whilst star gazing – an absolute luxury. Additionally, the house boasts a beautiful pool with a deck and lounges for guests to relax and enjoy mountain and sea views. Accommodating 6 adults and 4 children, the house provides swimming towels for added convenience.

The 10 sleeper house is ideal for 6 adults and 4 children. It offers a roomy lounge with comfortable sofas, and a fireplace. The front veranda offers an alfresco dining experience with distant views of the beach. The gaming room with tennis and foosball tables as well as a dartboard, will keep all ages occupied for hours on end.

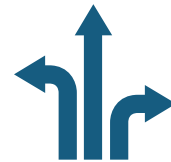
The mostly glass enclosed spacious dining area takes full advantage of the beautiful surrounds, whilst boasting a wind protected indoor braai/BBQ. The kitchen is fully equipped with a fridge/freezer, stove with gas hob, microwave oven and dishwasher.

Four bedrooms (one with fireplace) and 3 bathrooms (one en-suite) completes the picture perfect stay. A double garage is an added bonus.

It is heaven for the hiking enthusiast. From your doorstep, there are various Nature Reserve trails for the beginner as well as more advanced hikers. Certainly the most well-known trail, leads towards the summit of Hangklip Mountain, with breath taking views over Moonlight Bay and the Lighthouse. Definitely worth the steep climb!

Visit the Stony Point Penguins in Betty's Bay, only a few kilometres away - no entrance fee will be charged, when you stay at this wonderful house.

This is the ideal location for the discerning guest who wants total seclusion, and enjoys nature, yet wants to be in close proximity to other conveniences. The small coastal village of Pringle Bay has a lot to offer - pristine beaches, great restaurants and coffee shops.



Directions

From Cape Town, take the N2 north. Just before Sir Lowry's Pass, turn right on to Sir Lowry's Pass Road. At the T-junction in Gordon's Bay, turn left on to the R44 (Clarence Drive), follow the road along the coast, past Rooi Els, turn right at the first sign for Pringle Bay/Hangklip. Access to the property is via Pringle Bay security gate. Continue straight onto Hangklip Road and turn sharp left into Stream Road. Follow the gravel road towards the starting point of the Hangklip/Brodie link hiking trail. Bliss on the Bay will be on the left-hand side.

The house is situated adjacent to a hiking trail which leads to Hangklip Mountain with views over the coast line of Pringle Bay. The house comprises a large lounge area, braai / dining room area, family bedroom (1) accommodates two adults and two children, bedroom (2) accommodates two adults with en-suite shower and toilet, bedroom (3) accommodates two adults, a loft bedroom accommodates two children, entertainment room area and reading nook. The house has a fully equipped kitchen and three bathrooms with toilets. A spacious porch at the entrance of the house allows for a panoramic view and access to a big open fenced garden. A key attraction is the private wood-fired Kol-Kol hot tub on the back deck, providing a luxurious experience of star-gazing. Additionally, the house boasts a beautiful pool with a deck and lounges for guests to relax and enjoy mountain and sea views.

BIRD WATCHING

From the comfort of the veranda or decked area, guests are spoiled with a beautiful view of the surrounding mountains, Pringle Bay shoreline and also the fynbos in the area. Be sure to bring a pair of binoculars as there are many bird species which can be spotted.

Species to look out for:

Greater Flamingo; Black Eagle; Bank Cormorant; Cape Rockjumper; Cape Spurfowl; Cape Sugarbird; Orange-breasted Sunbird; Cape Bulbul; African Black Oystercatcher

Visit Stony Point Nature Reserve in Betty's Bay for a close-up view of the Endangered African penguin and four species of Cormorant (Endangered Cape Cormorant, Endangered Bank Cormorant, Crowned Cormorant and White Breasted Cormorant).



DAY WALKS

Hangklip/Brodie Link Trail

Trail Length: 5km

Estimated time: 2-3 hours

Access: Open access via gate in Clarence Road, Pringle Bay

This is quite a steep climb in the Hangklip/Pringle Bay area. Wear comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen, and a hat. Make sure to take a jacket as the weather can change quickly, carry sufficient food and water and remember to take your binoculars along.

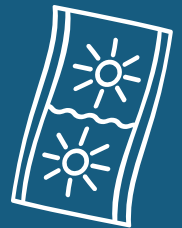
