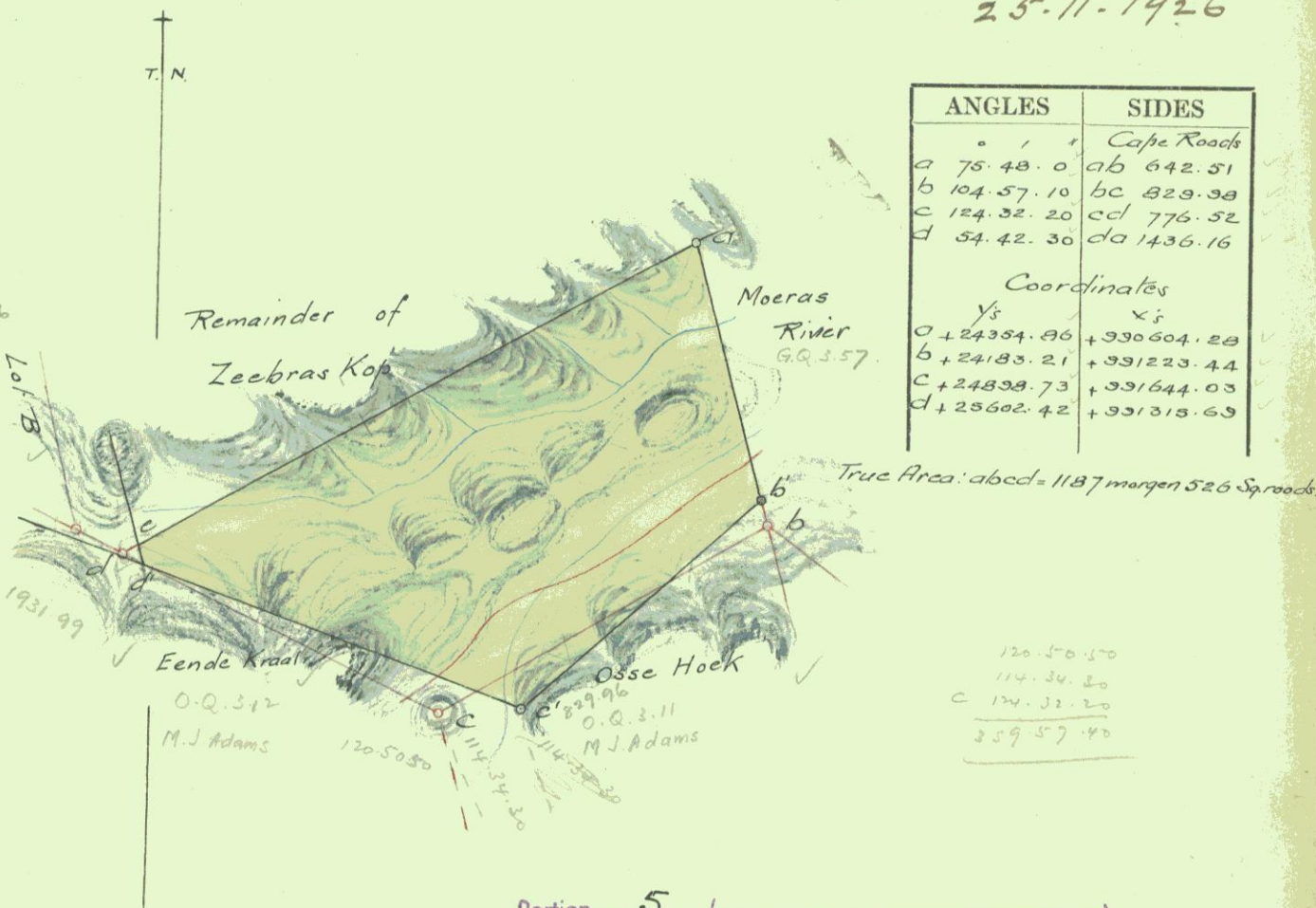

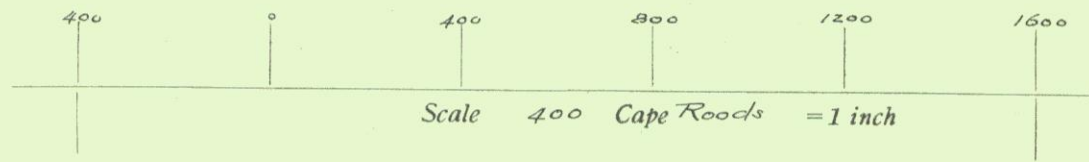

Survey Zeebraskop
Situated in the Division of Oudtshoorn.
Lot C of Zeebraskop.

This is to certify that I found beacons at the Corners marked a b c and the Corner beacons of the farm at the western extremity of the line ed produced. The beacons all consist of Cairns of stones about $4\frac{1}{2}$ to 5 feet in height + symmetrically built on bases of about 4' in diameter. I am satisfied that they are the valid original beacons of the farm. The late Surveyor Adams made a subdivision of the farm in 1873 + in his superposition made the line a b coincident with a b, but as my red line does not agree with his it is difficult to follow any superposition that will maintain the same relative positions of the red line + black line figures. X
I investigated the eastern boundary of Lot B and found several line beacons + also the S.E. corner beacons of Lot B so that I have no hesitation in stating that I am satisfied as to the validity of the beacons.

On the owner's copy of original diagram the deduction (shown as No. 1 on Outline Geop L/B 61) is marked Lot A + Lot B. Lot B is a triangular portion adjoining the remainder. JPK
